

What is the International Drug Program?

A program that significantly reduces expensive specialty drug costs for patients and employers. Patients will travel to the DaVinci Centre in the Cayman Islands free of charge to receive treatment including a physician consultation and their specialty drugs.

What is the DaVinci Centre?

A specialty medical facility run by licensed, experienced professionals who treat diseases and practice preventative and restorative medicine. Established in 2009, the DaVinci Centre specializes in infusion therapies, and innovatively combines state of the art western medicine with alternative healing practices.

Are the specialty drugs I will receive at the DaVinci Centre the same as the specialty drugs I am receiving through my current pharmacy or medical facility?

Yes, you will receive the same brand name drugs from the same manufacturers that you receive at your current pharmacy or medical facility.

How often will I need to visit the DaVinci Centre?

Depending on the type of medication (pill, injection, or infusion), you will return every 3-6 months for treatment. After experiencing the island's beauty and the attentive treatment from the DaVinci Centre team, patients anticipate returning for future treatments.

Do I have to change doctors to use the program?

No, your treatment plan and care will continue to be handled by your US-based doctor(s). This program is way to save on the high costs of specialty drug treatment; it does not replace your relationship with your US-based physician(s).

Am I required to use this **International Drug Program for my** specialty drug treatment?

No, the program is voluntary. However, if you initially choose not to participate, you are welcome to opt in at a later time.

Am I responsible for the travel and lodging costs for treatment in the Cayman Islands?

No, all costs are covered by your employer group. Patients receive roundtrip airfare and luxury hotel accommodations at no cost. Plus, free transportation services on the island along with extra spending cash and personalized concierge service. Airfare can be arranged from anywhere in the U.S.

In what ways will this available International Drug Program save me money?

By receiving your high cost specialty drug treatment through this program, you help to reduce your healthcare costs. Also, many employers provide incentives to members who use the program. If you are on high cost specialty medication check with your employer group to find out if you're eligible to participate.

How can I find out if my specialty drug(s) are available through PriceMDs' International Drug Program?

Our program covers approximately 175 specialty drugs with new ones being added to the list regularly. Chances are, if you are on a high-cost specialty medication, we have it available through our program. For more information, please contact our Nurse Navigator at 813-833-7158.

Who is eligible for the program?

The physicians at the DaVinci Centre, review each patients' medical records to determine who is clinically appropriate to participate in the program.

Is there a minimum age requirement for using the program?

Adults and children under 18 are eligible if they meet clinical criteria. For children under 18, an additional round-trip airfare is provided for a parent or guardian to accompany the child.

If my drug is available through the program, what happens next?

PriceMDs' Nurse Navigator Team will assist you every step of the way including transfer of medical records to the DaVinci Centre, coordinating treatment visits, and arranging air travel and hotel accommodations.

Do I need a passport to use the program?

Yes, a passport is required for travel to the Cayman Islands.

What happens at the end of my visit to the DaVinci Centre?

You'll receive your medication (if drug needs to be in a temperature-controlled environment, the proper storage container will be supplied) and necessary paperwork to return home with your medication. In addition, you will receive medical notes about your DaVinci Centre consultation to keep for your records and share with your US-based doctor(s).

How will I know it is time to return to the DaVinci Centre for my next treatment?

The Nurse Navigator Team records the dates of each patient visit and will contact you approximately 6-8 weeks before it is time for your next treatment at the DaVinci Centre. Just like the initial trip, the care concierge team will assist you every step of the way.
