WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Eligible for consideration are legal dependents of any active, retired or deceased DWU member.

Applicants must be:

- High School Senior
- College Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior or Senior
- Student in first or second yr. Technical School
- High School Graduate who has been out of school for no more than two years and who has not yet started college or Technical School.

Applicants must have:

- Current minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 or equivalent

HOW TO APPLY

Completed applications must be mailed to Diesel Workers Union by U.S. mail and postmarked no later than Feb. 21, 2020.

⇒ Counselor Verification. This application must be signed by your counselor/administrator.

⇒ Current Transcript of grades and grade point average

Your typewritten essay must be approximately 500 words using Times New Roman 12-pt font with 1-inch margins. Please double space the essay.

HOW THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM WORKS SELECTION

The Scholarship Committee will award the scholarships. Selection of winners is determined through an evaluation of academic records, a written application, an approximately 500-word essay, and a possible interview.

AMOUNT

Up to three (3) scholarships, each valued at \$1,000.00 will be awarded

Number of scholarships awarded and amount of monies are depended upon DWU Sports & Recreation events

A new application must be submitted for consideration each year.

PAYMENT OF AWARD

Upon admittance, the award is deposited in the student's name at the school of his/her choice.
