

Earn College Credit in High School!

Does your student want to experience college life while still in high school? Are they looking for a more challenging summer schedule? Summer College for High School Students is a **for-credit** opportunity open to students who have completed their sophomore year, are at least 16 years old (by the time classes begin), and have at least a 3.30 GPA.

Summer College for High School Students is an opportunity for students to live on campus and experience college life while earning credit toward their future degree. Students have access to more than 700 courses, including over 200 online options!

We currently offer various options for enrollment for high school students, which can be found below:

- **On-campus and online regular courses**
 - o Courses are offered in 4, 8, and 12 week modules.
 - o Students can pick what best fits their summer needs!
- **1-week, 1-credit courses**
 - o We are excited to be offering this experience for the second summer, expanding the program to 6 courses – including a new edition of Data Science and STEM!

Students may earn up to 7 credits in a summer. We do not charge a program fee, students pay the standard Purdue tuition and fees. The estimated cost for Indiana Residents for the programs can be found below:

**Students who choose to live on-campus will have an additional cost for room and board, around \$1,500 for 4 weeks.*

Credits earned through the program are Purdue credits and will appear on an official Purdue transcript. They may be brought with the student to Purdue or transferred to another university if applicable. The 2020 application for Summer College for High School Students opened December 1, 2019. The priority application deadline is March 1, 2020.

Statistically, 60% of Purdue students who graduate in 4 years or less have taken at least 1 summer course. If a student graduates early they can net between \$22,300 and \$52,094 more than their peers who graduate in 4 years.
