

- Each room in the house yields three integers. Look at them as a computer would see them.
- Each set of three integers yields a single word. Feel the ones.
- The map is current. Everyone (including the victim) has moved (or been moved) since the murder.
- Everyone moved clockwise around the house.
- No two people moved the same number of rooms distance from where they were when the murder took place.
- No one moved more than seven rooms distance.
- Exactly three people were alone in a room when the murder took place.
- The murderer was in the same room as the victim at the time of the murder.
- The rooms that are unoccupied now were also empty when the murder was committed.
- Only one innocent person walked past the room the victim's body ended up on their way to their destination.
- Only one pair of adjacent rooms were unoccupied when the murder took place.
- The total number of rooms (distance) moved by people who were not alone at the time of the murder is 14.
- The weapon is hidden in a room with no people. To find it you will need to use a Vigenere key that is an anagram of the missing word in this movie dialog: "Put them in the iron maiden." "Iron Maiden?" "Excellent!" "Execute them." "_____."
