

Consequences

Depending on the severity or recurrence of a behavior problem, the following are possible consequences of breaking any class or school rules:

- Nonverbal reminder
- Verbal reminder
- Student-teacher conference
- After School Detention (ASD)
- Lunch detention
- Phone call home

If a particular problem continues, you will be asked to

see the dean, who will take disciplinary action. I don't anticipate this happening often; I would much rather work together to make our Literature class a successful experience for all Navigators.



Grades

The grade scale I use in my class is the same as the school's. Assignments, quizzes, and tests are entered in as total points and typically not weighted.

90-100% - A

80-89% - B

70-79% - C

60-69% - D

59 or lower—F

Homework

Homework will be collected at the beginning of class on the day it is due—typically the day after it was assigned. If it is turned in late, students will earn half the points they would have earned for full credit. For example, if the student earned 8/10 on the assignment, but turned it in late, they will receive 4/10.
