Too sick for school?

If your child has the following symptoms, THEY SHOULD NOT BE AT SCHOOL.

FEVER: temperature of 100 degrees or more

No return until temperature under 100 degrees <u>without medicine</u> for at least 24 hours <u>VOMITTING</u>: vomiting in last 24 hours

DIARRHEA: two or more episodes of diarrhea in the last 24 hours

EYES: thick mucus or pus draining from the eye or pink eye (conjunctivitis)

No return until 24 hours after beginning antibiotic eye drops

<u>HEAD LICE</u>: may not return to school until they have been treated and seen by the nurse.

Bus transportation will be denied until recheck and cleared by school nurse.

<u>SKIN:</u> unknown rashes or skin lesions (open sores)
