
Third Grade - Stone Soup Opera

On Indiana University's 2,500 acre outdoor campus you could find students learning in all kinds of diverse settings. While hiking through the woods, students learned about animal adaptations and interactions among species. In the creek, they found benthic macroinvertebrates and determined the quality of the water. While on the night hike, they explored how the rods and cones in our eyes function and how diurnal, nocturnal, and crepuscular animals fill the niche in their environments. Students also had the chance to fish, do archery, throw an atl-atl, and cook hot dogs over an open fire. Responsibility is key at camp as students take care of their cabin, set up and clean up meals, prepare each day's weather report, and put up and take down the flag each day. 




